



Parks Maintenance Budget





City of Camas-definition of Park Ambassador

***Stewardship** definition:

The responsible overseeing and protection of something considered worth caring for and preserving.

What's my role?

Visit the park at least once a week to enjoy and observe.

The key is to enjoy your park!

Observe what users are enjoying (i.e. what's working), if there are any issues (i.e. grass too tall, need trash removal...).

Speak with park users, if you are comfortable, about the park (i.e. get their perspective - what's working or needs improvement)

Email your observations to the Parks & Recreation Director.

Be ready to share a unique story/observation at the monthly Parks & Recreation Commission.

- Adopting a park is a great way to make a difference in the community. This program provides many different ways for local groups, families, and businesses to get involved and help keep our parks safe and clean.

What does it mean to adopt a park?

- Adopting a park is a great way for local groups, individuals or organizations to get involved in the community. The primary goal for park adopters is to help keep the parks safe and clean. This can be done through individual park patrols, work parties, or large community events.

What is required to adopt a park?

- Fill out an Adopt-a-Park Application
- Set up a meeting with the Volunteer Coordinator to discuss adoption details and create a park work plan based on adopted park and group needs
- Complete weekly/monthly tasks (less required in winter months)
- Complete at least two (2) service projects each year




Schmid Baseball Field-Construction has started

Campen Creek Bridge- Construction will Start this Fall




Permanent Dog Park in Washougal-.33 Acres






Tigard Downtown Dog Park





Dog Park Justification

- The City currently owns the property behind City Hall, which is .33 acres
- This park has plenty of parking on the street and parking lot
- City of Washougal's citizens top priority is a Dog Park
- The City of Tigard Downtown Park is smaller footprint .29 acres, but was one of the most popular parks the city has
- The cost of this dog park is affordable due to already owning the land and park available
- City of Tigard big event was Dog Park Halloween Costume Contest





Dog Park Cost

- Fencing \$15,000-\$20,000
- Dog Park features (benches, trash cans, dog play area, dog bags) \$15,000-\$20,000
- Dog Park sidewalk and bark chips \$15,000-\$20,000
- Water fountain for dogs \$5,000-\$10,000
- Signage \$500


TOTAL park can be built \$50,000 to \$70,000



Staff Recommended Park Impact Fee

City of Washougal Park Impact Fee Update, 3-Year Phased Implementation Rate Schedule

Type of Development	2021	2022	2023
	(54%)	(77%)	(100%)
Single Family	\$3,490.66	\$4,977.43	\$6,464.19
Multifamily	\$2,529.85	\$3,607.37	\$4,684.90

- **3-Year Phased Implementation:** City staff recommend a 3-year phased implementation schedule based on the combined feedback from City Council, Planning Commission, and the Builders Association of Clark County.
- **Annual Inflation Index:** The recommended index is the June to June Engineering News Record Construction Cost Index for Seattle (ENR-CCI). The annual inflation adjustment will begin January 1, 2024, after the completion of the phased implementation schedule.


