


# OAK TREE PARK

## Washougal Parks Department



### History of Oak Tree Park:

This Southern face of Woodburn Hill was once used for hayfields and pastureland. Outcrops of Oregon White Oak trees dotted the rocky hillside, but this one acre savanna of Oaks grew in the middle of a future subdivision. The Lookout Ridge development surrounded this grove of Oak trees and naturally became the ideal site for a neighborhood park. The developer had admirable plans to utilize utility easements for trail connectivity; however, only part of these plans have materialized.

The City of Washougal took over maintenance of Oak Tree Park in 2009.

**Amenities:**  
Asphalt trail, benches, picnic tables, playground, street parking, views.

**Recreation Opportunities:**  
This site provides amazing views of the Columbia River, Oregon, Mt Hood in the distance, and Washougal below. The flat grassy setting surrounded by mature Oregon White Oak trees offers a serene and scenic location for family picnics. The playground is designed for 2-5 year old children.
